
Part Identification

our ABCs.




⚡ While not all parts are labeled, some of the parts will have a label or an inked letter on the edge to help distinguish similar parts from each other. Use this part identification to help identify similar parts.

A	LEFT END (1)
B	RIGHT END (1)
C	FRAME (2)
D	BRACE (4)
E	BACK BRACE (1)
F	GLASS TOP (1)
G	SHELF (1)




Step 1

- ⚠ Assemble your unit on a carpeted floor or on the empty carton to avoid scratching your unit or the floor.
- ⚠ Fasten the BRACES (D) to one of the FRAMES (C). Tighten four 1/2" HEX HEAD SCREWS (7) using the L-WRENCH (3).




Step 2

- Fasten the remaining FRAME (C) to the BRACES (D).
Tighten four 1/2" HEX HEAD SCREWS (7) using the L-WRENCH (3).




Step 3

- ✚ Fasten the SHELF (G) to the FRAMES (C). Use six 1/2" PAN HEAD SCREWS (6).
- ✚ NOTE: You should start each SCREW a few turns before completely tightening any of them.




Step 4

- Fasten the ENDS (A and B) to the SHELF (G). Tighten six 1/2" HEX HEAD SCREWS (7) using the L-WRENCH (3).
- NOTE:** You should start each SCREW a few turns before completely tightening any of them.




Step 5

- Fasten the BACK BRACE (E) to the ENDS (A and B).
Tighten four 1" MACHINE SCREWS (5) and four NUTS (1) using the WRENCH (4) and a screwdriver.



Step 6

- ✦ Carefully stand your unit upright.
- ✦ Peel a GLASS SPACER (2) from the GLASS SPACER CARD (2) and stick them onto the tabs of the FRAMES (C).
- ✦ Place the GLASS TOP (F) with the shiny surface facing up onto the GLASS SPACERS.
- ✦ NOTE: Please read the back pages of the instruction booklet for important safety information.
- ✦ This completes assembly. Clean with a damp cloth. Wipe dry.
